“LET US REASON TOGETHER”
ISAIAH 1:15-20 | JAKE HUFFMAN

To understand the Prophetic Books of the Bible that call the people to repentance or they will undergo judgment, we must know that God has called Israel to be His wife.

- Isaiah 54:5
- God is “all in”. It’s a covenant. Israel is His beloved wife. He has taken her for himself. She is His chosen one. He gives Himself to her. He is not indifferent toward her.
- Israel’s heart was not “all in”. She prayed to the LORD but had reduced it to merely lifeless, empty routines and rituals. V.11-15

God reasons with His spouse. V.18 Israel needed to be cut to the heart by their lack of heart-felt love for God treating Him like one among many.

Actions (obedience) then turn these affections into commitment.

If love is not deepening over time, it wilts and wanes producing indifference, staleness and a “going through the motions” relationship.

Revelation 2:4

Whatever has stolen your heart away from God, uproot it, confess it out, remove it, turn away from it and renew your love for Jesus. That place in your heart is for Jesus alone.
