“A SURE FOUNDATION”
ISAIAH 28:16 | JAKE HUFFMAN

God promised Israel safety v.12, but Israel’s (Ephraim) leaders made covenants with other nations for security against the Assyrian superpower who threatened their land. They trusted in the false assurances of other nations who pledged their help. V.15

In the day of battle these other nations did not come to their aid. Except for Jerusalem, the land was plundered by the Assyrians. Many perished or were led away into captivity and slavery. V.17-19

What led them astray?

1. They got drunk on wine and beer. V.7
 - They overindulged in and abused the abundant provision of grain and new wine God had blessed Israel with. It clouded their judgment and dulled their spiritual discernment.
 - I Peter 5:7,8
2. They believed the false promises of security the world offered them.
 - Nations didn’t care about Israel, but Israel couldn’t see that.
 - Psalm 118:8,9

A fundamental need of humanity is for security. What can we trust? Isaiah 28:16

- “Precious Cornerstone”: God’s very own Son is our safe place.
- “Tested Stone”: Jesus has proven that he cares for you.
- Promise: Trust Him and you will never panic.
